2. GENERAL STATEMENT

On February 22, 2017, the Tonasket School Board made a decision to rescind the administrative leave of Coach Landdeck through the end of this current boys’ basketball season. This decision resulted in a reduction, not elimination of the disciplinary action imposed on Coach Landdeck. The decision to hire Mr. Landdeck as the boys basketball coach at Tonasket High School for the coming year will be made on Friday, March 10 at 7:00 p.m. No public comment will be taken at that Friday board meeting. The decision to allow a temporary reinstatement was not unanimous and was in opposition to the Superintendent's recommendation.

The Board is holding this public hearing tonight to receive comments and will be dedicated to hearing from the public. There will be no deliberation or decisions made by the Board at this meeting.

3. PUBLIC HEARING PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES

The board recognizes the value of public comment and the importance of the involvement of community members in the school. In order to permit fair and orderly expression of comments, the board will allow individuals to express an opinion based on the following guidelines:

- Individuals wishing to be heard by the board will print their first and last name on the sign-in sheet. These individuals wishing to speak will be recognized by the board chair and will be invited to the podium.
- All speakers must speak into the microphone and give your first and last name before proceeding with your comment. This hearing is being recorded.
- The time limit on speaking is: 3 minutes. The board will keep the time and you will be notified if you go over the time allotment.
- If you are in a group with mutual opinions, please appoint a representative to speak on behalf of the group.
- Avoid repetitive or irrelevant comments.
- Unruly behavior, such as booing or hissing is prohibited. Personal attacks will not be allowed.

(Individuals with disabilities who may need a modification to participate in the public hearing should contact the superintendent’s office no later than three days before the meeting so that arrangements for the modification can be made.)
