Tonasket School District students are housed in one K-5 building, one 6-8 building, one 9-12 building, and two ALE buildings that serves students in our Choice High School and Outreach Homeschool Program. The district-wide high poverty rate is 67.34%. ELL, migrant, and students receiving services are integrated into regular classrooms and are provided pull-out services as needed.

Each is a life-long learner who possesses the skills to think critically, act intelligently, work creatively, and confidently adapt to an ever-changing world.
