Good Morning!

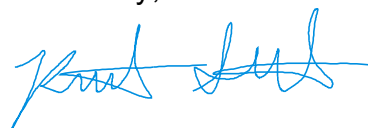

Hello Janet,

Here is my suggested 5 district plan for Tonasket School District.

Attached is a series of maps and reports. The first map is an overall district map in 17x22 poster size. This is followed by the two base population reports the key showing very good population counts per district using the guideline of population 'as equal as possible'.

I try to take a minimal change approach to redistricting and grow or shrink districts based primarily on the change to population. I quickly noticed that the river could be used as a division line with no district needing to be split by it. The old districts had some good simple lines to work with and I tried to play off those as I made the population more balanced.

In the western two districts, the hard part was having a good describable line dividing the two. In the past, there were lines that did not follow any named or easy to recognized geography. The 4th district grew south to pick up the land previously assigned to the 2nd where it crossed the river. The only change to the 3rd and 5th district border area is where there was some Census Block consolidation. The 3rd district did grow into the 4th district and without the fingers the 4th used to have and now a simpler line.

Page 4 – 9 are overviews of each district but do to the size of land area, only the 4th has street labels. Page 9 – 19 are insets showing the areas of change with the old district line in a wide green line to assist quickly assessing these changes. Page 20 is an overview of the previous districts.

I feel this proposed plan meets all the statutes of RCW 29a.76.010. Equal in population as possible, contiguous, compact, no disfavoring any groups/parties, and protecting Areas of Common Interest.

Please have the board review these maps and reports. Do they have any questions with this work? Do they like my proposal? Once the board is satisfied with a redistricting plan, I will create a "Metes and Bounds" legal description and an interchange file for the County GIS department. Then the board will have to have a public meeting with at least a week notice. After public comments, the board can ratify the new redistrict plan with a resolution.

Then you can submit the maps, legal, and interchange file to the County, done for ten more years. Let me know if any questions come up or I can be further help.
